
YOU, YOUR MOTORCYCLE & SAILING ON THE NORTH COAST WATERS



For the safety of passengers and crew and to protect personal property, all motorcycles shall be secured by the rider during North Coast Waters crossings. The rider is responsible for ensuring their motorcycle is secure to the satisfaction of the Loading Officer and assumes all risk of damages during this process. Designated racks or tiedown locations and straps are provided. The following procedures shall be performed to secure the motorcycle:

- Place motorcycle in the lowest gear;
- Place front tire in holder (where provided) and strapped down to the eye bolt or to the deck securing devices with the forward shocks compressed;
- Have the loading Officer inspect the motorcycle to ensure it is properly secured;
- Return to your motorcycle when announcements are made and prior to arrival, leaving the securing devices on the motorcycle until after the vessel has safely docked.

If you have any concerns, please do not hesitate to discuss with a member of the deck crew. They will be more than happy to assist.

BC Ferries reserves to right to refuse passage to riders who refuse to secure their motorcycles for the transit of North Coast Waters and to the satisfaction of the Loading Officer.
